

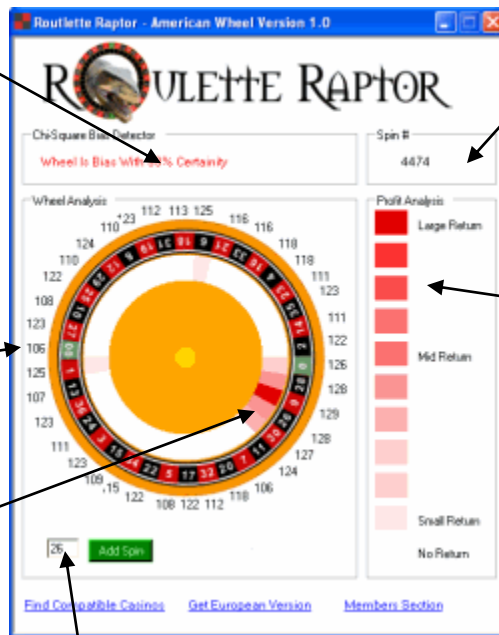
ADVANCED ROULETTE WHEEL-BIAS DETECTION SOFTWARE

ROULETTE RAPTOR

Bias Detector: Using a Chi-Square analysis, the bias detector can find with 90-99% certainty if the wheel is bias. If the wheel is bias, use the profitability colors to make betting decisions.

Total pocket count

Pocket Profitability Indicator: refer to chart and bias detector to make betting choices



Total Spins for the session: 200 spins are required for the bias detector to

Pocket Profitability Chart: The color represent profitability based on the wheels return. White is non-profitable. Light pink is just slightly better than breaking even. Dark pink is an ok return. Dark return is a very good return. These colors are only valid suggestion if the wheel has been detected as bias by the *Chi-Square Bias Detector*

7 Rules To Keep In Mind When Using Roulette Raptor:

- 1.** Only use on a real live wheel. Computer generated wheels use a Random Number Generator that should not be bias.
 - 2.** Start out with the lowest wager possible for the first 200 spins. It takes at least 200 spins for the chi-square analysis to come into play. You may choose to bet on more frequent numbers before 200 spins, but without the chi-square analysis you will not know if they are due to luck or bias. If possible, observe the wheel without making bets. Only increase your bets if the Raptor finds the wheel to be bias (or you just want to lose money)
 - 3.** The red colors represent how profitable that number has been to date. If you were in retrospect to have bet the whole time on that red number, you would of made a profit. The redder the number, the more profitable. White numbers are non-profitable.
 - 4.** The red does not mean that the number(s) is predicted to be profitable in the long term. It only means that it has been profitable to date. Even on a non-bias wheel, about 15 numbers would of been profitable after 200 spins and about 1 would of still been profitable after 1000.
- Only use the profitability colors as a serious betting indicator if the chi-square analysis finds the wheel to be bias. The more spins you observe, the more certain you can be. It won't hurt to stick to non-white numbers white waiting for the first 200 spins.
- 5.** Taper your bets according to profitability colors. Put most your bets on dark red and some on the lighter red.
 - 6.** Try to use the European wheel version instead of the American. The European version is 196% more profitable due to not having a 00.
 - 7.** Don't use the same data for different wheels, as this will corrupt the data. Stick to one wheel only. If the wheel is changed while playing, restart Roulette Raptor. You may want to consider even restarting Roulette Raptor after dealers change, incase there is a dealer influenced bias.
